What are your thoughts about sharing occurrences within your family with others outside of your family (extended family, friends, colleagues, church members, pastor, etc.)?
How will decisions (major, minor, everyday decisions) be made?

#### WHAT ARE YOUR GOALS FOR PARENTING?

What are your beliefs about discipline?
What are your thoughts about schooling/education?
What is/will be the role for each of you as mother and father?
How do you define success?
What are the ultimate goals for your child(ren)?
How will you help them grow mentally, emotionally, socially and physically?
What will be the role of extended family members and friends in the lives of your children?

#### HOW WILL YOU MANAGE YOUR FINANCES?

Will you commit to faithfully tithing? 10%? More than 10%? What about a faithful offering?
Who will develop/manage the budget?
Will you have a joint bank account or separate accounts?
